

OVERBID PROCEDURE

The bidding for the "Property" shall begin with Homan's offer for the "Property" of \$15,245.50. In the event a party wishes to participate in the overbid procedure the bidding only for the "Inventory" The bidding shall begin with Homan's offer of \$11,495.50. Should a party wish to participate in the overbid procedure for only the "Vehicle" the bidding shall be with Homan's offer of \$3,750.00, (each of Homan's offers whether they are for the "Property," the "Inventory," or the "Vehicle," are hereinafter referred to as the minimum bid.) subject to overbid in increments of not less than \$100.00. That the Court approves the sale to the highest and best bidder as selected and determined by the Trustee. The sale is to be "as is", "where is", with all faults and without representation or warranty by the Trustee. The successful bidder shall be responsible for delivery and/or transportation of the Property from its present location in Fontana, California. The successful bidder shall have not more than five (5) days from the date of entry of the order approving the sale to arrange to pick up the asset from its present location. If the successful bidder does not pick up the Property from it's location within said five (5) days, the Trustee shall be entitled to charge the successful bidder any reasonable costs for storage thereafter. Trustee shall be entitled to seek such orders of the United States Bankruptcy Court in aid of the enforcement of any order authorizing such sale.

In order to protect the estate against the possibility that the successful bidder will ultimately fail to perform, all parties who wish to participate in the sale bidder shall be required to deposit with the Trustee, as a precondition to participate in the bidding and prior to the time of the hearing, a certified check or money order in the amount of \$1,525.00, for either the Inventory, the Vehicle or the Property, payable to Karl T. Anderson, Chapter 7 Trustee, the balance of the purchase price shall be payable in the like manner not later than two (2) business days from the conclusion of the sale. In the event the buyer fails to perform within the prescribed period, the deposit shall be non-refundable and immediately forfeit upon such default. Further, the Trustee shall be relieved of any obligation to sell either the Inventory, the Vehicle or

the Property to such defaulting buyer and said forfeiture shall not be construed as liquidated damages but shall be deemed to be the minimum amount of damages suffered by the estate without prejudice to the Trustee's or the bankruptcy estate's right to pursue further damages for any and all breaches by the successful bidder (Buyer). In the event the buyer does perform, the deposit shall be credited to the purchase price. The items of property may be examined in person by appointment only.
