

NOTICE RE SCHEDULING ORDERS

TO EXPEDITE PROCESSING OF SCHEDULING ORDERS, THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES ARE APPLICABLE FOR ALL SCHEDULING ORDERS IN ADVERSARY PROCEEDINGS PENDING BEFORE JUDGE ALBERTS:

1. The Court will prepare the Scheduling Order.
2. At the time that the Status Report is filed pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 7016-1, Plaintiff(s) shall provide completed Notice Of Entry forms and postage-paid, addressed envelopes necessary to enable the Court Clerk's office to give notice of entry of the Order in accordance with the applicable federal and local rules.
3. All Notice Of Entry forms should indicate that the order is entitled "Scheduling Order".

FAILURE TO COMPLY MAY RESULT IN DISMISSAL OF THE ADVERSARY PROCEEDING FOR LACK OF PROSECUTION WITHOUT FURTHER NOTICE.
