YOU MUST CALL THE CALENDAR CLERK, EMMA GONZALEZ, AT (818)587-2832 IF YOU WOULD LIKE A HEARING DATE FOR THE FOLLOWING, **MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT, DISCLOSURE STATEMENT, AND MOTION TO DISMISS THE ADVERSARY PROCEEDING.**

(A) MOTIONS FOR RELIEF FROM THE AUTOMATIC STAY ALL CHAPTERS ON REGULAR NOTICE May be set on THURSDAY mornings at 9:30 a.m. **EXCEPT FOR: 4/2/09, 5/14/09,**

If you choose a date beyond 30 days from the date you filed your motion, you are deemed to have waived the time limits of Bankruptcy Code Sect. 362(e), and you must then file a declaration to that effect.

(B) Residential unlawful detainer Motion for Relief from Stay in all chapters where judgment for possession has been granted Pre-Petition may be heard on shortened notice on Thursdays at 9:30 A.M. The moving party must file and serve the moving papers on the Debtor and other Interest Parties 7 days before the hearing. Notice on the debtor must be telephonic and personal service of the pleadings or telephonic, mail & posting . For further compliance, moving party must refer to LBR 9075-1 and 4001-1.

(C) Motions to Continue or Reimpose The Automatic Stay under section 362(c)(3) or (c)(4)- These motions DO NOT require an application for an order shortening time IF 14 days notice is given to all interested parties including the secured creditor(s). These motions are heard on Thursdays at 10:00 a.m. If 14 days notice cannot be given, then an application for order shortening time is necessary. See section G Below.

(D) CH. 7 INTERIM FEE APPLICATIONS, CH. 11 INTERIM AND FINAL FEE APPLICATIONS May be set on TUESDAYS AT 2:00 p.m., EXCEPT 5/5/09, 5/12/09, 6/2/09, 6/23/09, 6/30/09, 7/7/09, 8/4/09, 10/6/09, 11/3/09, 12/1/09

(E) CH. 13 MISC. MOTIONS **May be set 4/7/09, 5/5/09, 6/2/09, 7/13/09, 8/4/09, 9/14/09, 10/6/09, 11/3/09, 12/1/09**
PLEASE NOTE: Motions to Avoid Lien and Objection to Claim are now heard @ 9:00 a.m. and ALL other MISC. matter are now set @ 11:00 a.m.

(F) MISCELLANEOUS MOTIONS FOR CH. 7 & 11 (EXCEPT FOR MOTIONS FROM RELIEF FROM AUTOMATIC STAY) CH.11 May be set on Tuesdays at 10:00 a.m. and CH. 7 at 10:00 a.m. or 11:00 a.m. **Except for 4/7/09, 5/5/09, 5/12/09, 6/2/09, 6/23/09, 6/30/09, 7/7/09, 8/4/09, 9/8/09, 10/6/09, 11/03/06 and 12/01/09**

MOTION TO APPROVE REAFFIRMATION AGREEMENTS - **May be set on Tuesday morning at 8:30 a.m., on 3/17/09, 4/28/09, 5/19/09, 6/16/09, 7/14/09, 8/18/09,**

(G) ALL OTHER EXPARTE OR EMERGENCY MOTIONS ON SHORTENED NOTICE- Please comply with Local Bankruptcy Rule 9075-1. You must file your moving papers with the Clerk's Office and have conformed courtesy copies delivered to the Judge's courtesy box adjacent to Courtroom "301". Approximately two to three days after the filing of your papers, applicants will be contacted by Law Clerk CAROLINE MANANKICHIAN with a hearing date and further instructions.
