THE DISCUSSION WILL INCLUDE TWO QUESTIONS, AMONG OTHERS, THAT CENTRAL DISTRICT BANKRUPTCY JUDGES ARE CONCERNED ABOUT:

- 1. IS OUR CURRENT PRACTICE CONCERNING POST-PETITION, PRE-CONFIRMATION MORTGAGE PAYMENTS IN CHAPTER 13 SATISFACTORY OR SHOULD WE CONSIDER CHANGING IT? IF SO, WHAT SHOULD THE NEW PROCEDURE BE?**
- 2. SHOULD WE CONSIDER CHANGING OUR RELIEF FROM STAY MANDATORY FORMS TO REQUIRE MORTGAGE LENDERS TO FURNISH A COMPLETE, DETAILED ACCOUNTING OF ALL PAYMENTS AND ALLEGED DEFAULTS?**
