RE: Electronic Bankruptcy Noticing

Effective immediately, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California will offer court bankruptcy notices via Internet e-mail or facsimile transmission. Participation in this free program is voluntary, and those not electing to receive electronic notices will continue to receive traditional printed notices via United States Postal mail.

In order to participate in this program, your e-mail provider must provide an electronic acknowledgment of receipt indicating that the notice was delivered to the intended electronic mailbox.

Electronic notices will be attached to the message as an Adobe Portable Document Format (PDF) file, and a PDF reader is available at no charge from Adobe's web site, www.adobe.com.
