RE: REVISIONS TO LOCAL BANKRUPTCY RULES AND FORMS

Revisions to the Local Bankruptcy Rules and forms for the Central District of California Bankruptcy Court have been approved and become effective August 1, 2005.

1002-1	<i>Form of Papers Filed with Court</i>	Paragraph (c) was added to define "Mandatory" forms. Former paragraph (c) and paragraph (h) were moved and renumbered L.B.R. 7003-1 and L.B.R. 7001-1, respectively, to comply with the Uniform Local Rule Numbering System.
2002-2	<i>Notice to United States Trustees or Federal Agencies</i>	Paragraph (a)(2)(A) was eliminated to reconcile L.B.R. 2002-2 with the new revision to L.B.R. 2014-1.
2014-1	<i>Employment of Debtor and Professional Persons</i>	Paragraph (a) was modified to clarify and revise the procedure for service of a "Notice of Insider Compensation." Paragraph (b) was revised to require that all employment applications be filed with the court rather than submitted first to the United States Trustee. An order authorizing employment may now be granted after 15 days notice of an opportunity to object and request a hearing served on the United States Trustee, creditors, and other parties in interest.
3007-1	<i>Objections to Claims</i>	Paragraph (a) was revised to correct a conflict between L.B.R. 3007-1 and L.B.R. 9013-1 concerning the time limit for service of a claim objection and notice of hearing. Paragraph (d) was added to require that the number assigned to the proof of claim on the court's claims register be included in the claim objection.
7001-1	<i>Pleadings in Adversary Proceedings</i>	Former L.B.R. 1002-1(h) was moved and renumbered L.B.R. 7001-1 to conform to the Uniform Local Rule Numbering System.
7003-1	<i>Adversary Proceeding Sheet</i>	Former L.B.R. 1002-1(c) was moved and renumbered L.B.R. 7003-1 to conform to the Uniform Local Rule Numbering System.
