26 1. Benjamin B. Wasson is hereby suspended for one year from practicing before
27 the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California from the date of
28 entry of this order.

2. Mr. Wasson shall immediately cease practicing in the United States Bankruptcy
Court for the Central District of California until he applies to be, and is in fact, restated
after the one year of suspension.

1 3. Mr. Wasson shall undertake and complete additional continuing legal education
2 of ten (10) hours of duration in the area of legal ethics offered by a provider of continuing
3 legal education recognized by the State Bar of California and submit written proof of
4 completion thereof before he may apply for reinstatement to practice before the United
5 States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California.

6 4. Copies of the Memorandum of Decision on Disciplinary Proceeding and this
7 Disciplinary Order shall be served by the Clerk of this Court on each Bankruptcy Judge
8 sitting in the Central District of California, on the Clerk of the United States District Court
9 for the Central District of California, and on the State Bar of California.
