Based on the Memorandum on Disciplinary Proceeding of Eric D. Johnson filed  
concurrently herewith (the "Memorandum"), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

- A. Mr. Johnson shall be placed on probation for three years beginning the day the Order is entered. During this period, any ethical violations shall be forwarded to the Chief Judge of the Bankruptcy Court for a determination of whether Mr. Johnson should be permanently suspended from practice before the Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California.

1 B. Mr. Johnson shall be suspended from practice before said Bankruptcy Court until he  
2 provides proof to the Chief Judge of the Bankruptcy Court of:

- 3 a. Completion of not less than 4 hours of instruction on the Rules of Professional  
4 Conduct for attorneys in the State of California from a provider of continuing  
5 legal education recognized by the State Bar of California;  
6 b. Passage of the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination; and  
7 c. Compliance with the provisions of the State Bar Act and Rules of Professional  
8 Conduct during the probation period.

9 C. A copy of this Memorandum and the Order entered concurrently herewith shall be  
10 delivered to each sitting judge of the Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of  
11 California, to the Clerk of the Court for the United States District Court for the Central  
12 District of California, and to the State Bar of California.




