

TENTATIVE RULING PROCEDURES FOR JUDGE THEODOR C. ALBERT

Tentative rulings are available via the Court's website. The Court issues tentative rulings whenever possible and appropriate prior to the scheduled hearing date. Tentative rulings are usually published by 4:00 p.m. the day prior to the scheduled hearings. Please do not call chambers to inquire about tentative rulings before 4:00 p.m.

If appearance is made optional and you would like to submit on the tentative ruling, please call Judge Albert's Courtroom Deputy, Glenda DeRamus, at (714) 338-5304 the **night before the hearing**. If she does not answer, please leave a message that you will submit on the tentative. If you call **on the day of the hearing** and cannot reach Glenda, please call chambers at (714) 338-5430 to advise that you will submit on the tentative. If the Court issues a tentative ruling in an uncontested matter and excuses the movant's appearance, or a party submits on the tentative ruling, but a party appears in court to contest the motion, the Court will listen briefly and either allow the tentative ruling to stand or continue the hearing to allow the absent parties to be heard. The parties should check the Court's docket to verify the outcome of the hearing.
