REMOTE HEARINGS

To mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus and in light of the recent directives from state and federal officials, all hearings before Judge Mund will be held remotely until further notice.

The courtroom will be locked; parties must appear by telephone or ZoomGov, as directed by the Court, and will not be permitted to appear in the courtroom. Check the Court's posted calendar for ZoomGov hearing information. <http://ecf-ciao.cacb.uscourts.gov/CiaoPosted/?jid=GM>

- (A) All Motions on all chapters: May be set on Tuesday at 10:00 a.m. ***on the following dates: 1/23/24, 2/20/24, 3/19/24, 4/23/24***

Please note: Motion for relief from stay. If you choose a date beyond 30 days from the date you file your motion, you are deemed to have waived the time limits of Bankruptcy Code Section 362(e).

- (B) Please note that new Local Rule 7056-1 (2) requires 42 days' notice for summary judgment motions and not the usual 21 days' notice.

- (C) Motions on Shortened Notice - These must comply with Local Bankruptcy Rule 9075-1. You must file your moving papers without a hearing date or time along with an Application for Order Shortening Time with the Bankruptcy Court Clerk's Office and have conformed copies of all documents delivered to Judge Mund's Courtesy Copy Box on the third floor of the Courthouse adjacent to the elevators. **Two days** after both the filing of the documents with the Bankruptcy Court Clerk's Office and delivery of courtesy copies, **applicant must contact Patty Garcia Courtroom Deputy for Judge Mund at (818) 587-2850, unless the Law Clerk has already called the applicant.**
