Panel membership is not restricted to attorneys. **Current panel members do not need to submit an application.**

A mediation training program of approximately thirty (30) hours will be required of the applicants chosen for the panel, unless attendance is excused by the judges for good cause shown. MCLE credit will be available upon completion of the training program.
