ORDER GRANTING IN PART AND DENYING IN PART DEBTOR'S MOTION TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE CASE OPENING DOCUMENTS

(No Hearing Required)

The court, having reviewed and considered Debtor Charmain Shanequa Colbert's ("Debtor") Motion To Extend Time To File Case Opening Documents ("Motion"), ECF 8, and good cause appearing,

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

CHARMAIN SHANEQUA COLBERT,

Debtor.

- 1. Debtor's Motion is granted in part and denied in part as follows.
- The deadline for Debtor to file her case opening documents in this case is extended to June 26, 2016, and Debtor must file her case opening documents no later than <u>June 26, 2016</u>.
- 3. If Debtor fails to file her case opening documents by <u>June 26, 2016</u>, her case shall be automatically dismissed effective on June 25, 2016 pursuant to Section 521(i)(1) of the Bankruptcy Code, 11 U.S.C., which provides that ". . . if an individual debtor in a voluntary case under chapter 7 or 13 fails to file all of

the information required under subsection (a)(1) [including Debtor's schedules and statement of financial affairs] within 45 days after the date of the filing of the petition, the case shall be automatically dismissed effective on the 46th day after the date of the filing of the petition. "Based on the papers filed by Debtor, there is no justifiable reason to extend this deadline beyond the statutory 45 days set forth in Section 521(i)(1). Debtor is taking a Chapter 7 workshop with Public Counsel on June 10, 2016 and should be able to file her required documents within two weeks, or 14 days, after the workshop. See 11 U.S.C. § 521(i)(3). Debtor's request to extend time to file these documents beyond June 26, 2016 to July 8, 2016 is DENIED.

4. No further extension of the deadline to file Debtor's case opening documents shall be granted unless Debtor shows cause that satisfies this court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
