Based on the Memorandum of Decision in Disciplinary Proceeding against Benjamin S. Nachimson, filed concurrently with this Order pursuant to The Sixth Amended General Order 96-05 of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California (“General Order”), it is hereby ORDERED:


1 1. Benjamin S. Nachimson (“Mr. Nachimson” or “Nachimson”) is suspended from
2 practicing before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California, for a
3 period of two (2) years from the date of entry of this Order.

4 2. In addition, Mr. Nachimson is ordered to complete ten (10) hours of continuing
5 legal education in ethics, from an educational provider approved by the State Bar of California,
6 and submit written proof of completion thereof, before he may be reinstated to practice before
7 the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California.


8 3. Mr. Nachimson may, after completion of the suspension term, apply for
9 reinstatement to practice before the Bankruptcy Court in accordance with the provisions of the
10 General Order, as it may be amended hereafter provided he has completed the required
11 continuing legal education. Any application for reinstatement must include evidence sufficient
12 to demonstrate that, after entry of the Discipline Order, Mr. Nachimson completed the above
13 continuing legal education requirements. The application for reinstatement shall also
14 demonstrate that he is in good standing with the State Bar of California and demonstrate that he
15 has met all additional Reinstatement requirements set forth in detail in The Sixth Amended
16 General Order 96-05.

17 4. Copies of the Memorandum of Decision in Disciplinary Proceeding and this
18 Disciplinary Order shall be served by the Clerk of this Court on each Bankruptcy Judge sitting in
19 the Central District of California, on the Clerk of the United States District Court for the Central
20 District of California, and on the State Bar of California.
