Based on the Memorandum of Decision in Disciplinary Proceeding against Adlore Clarambeau, filed concurrently with this Order pursuant to Fourth Amended General Order 96-05 of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. Adlore Clarambeau is suspended from practicing before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California for five years, commencing upon the effective date of this Order.

2. Upon the expiration of this suspension period, Adlore Clarambeau may apply for reinstatement to practice before the Bankruptcy Court.

3. As a condition to reinstatement to practice before the United States Bankruptcy Court of the Central District of California, Adlore Clarambeau shall submit evidence of payment of all monies he has been required to disgorge by order of this court and of any other court.

4. Mr. Clarambeau shall also undertake and complete additional continuing legal education of fifteen (15) hours of duration in the area of legal ethics offered by a provider of

1 continuing legal education recognized by the State Bar of California, and submit written proof of
2 completion thereof, before he may apply for reinstatement to practice before the United States
3 Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California.

4 5. Copies of the Memorandum of Decision in Disciplinary Proceeding and this
5 Disciplinary Order shall be served by the Clerk of this Court on each Bankruptcy Judge sitting in
6 the Central District of California, on the Clerk of the United States District Court for the Central
7 District of California, and on the State Bar of California.
