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6 **IT IS HEREBY:**

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8 **ORDERED:** That Henry Steelman (“Steelman”) is publicly reprovved for failing to
9 adequately supervise non-attorney agents, failing to perform services with competence, and
10 aiding non-attorneys in the unauthorized practice of law;

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12 **ORDERED:** That Steelman’s privilege of practicing before the Bankruptcy Court for
13 the Central District of California is suspended commencing as of the date of this order;

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15 **ORDERED:** That Steelman shall disgorge fees in accordance with the Disgorgement
16 Stipulation;

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18 **ORDERED:** That Steelman shall file a copy of the Disgorgement Stipulation in all cases
19 pending before any bankruptcy judge in the Central District of California in which he represents
20 a debtor, including acting as appearance counsel, for sixty months as of the date of this order and
21 that he make the contributions as set forth in the Disgorgement Stipulation;

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23 **ORDERED:** That Steelman shall undertake Continuing Legal Education as set forth the
24 Disgorgement Stipulation;

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26 **ORDERED:** That this Disciplinary Panel shall retain jurisdiction to enforce any and all
27 aspects of this order and that Steelman may seek reinstatement to practice before the Bankruptcy
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1 Court for the Central District of California upon noticed motion to this Disciplinary Panel
2 consisting of the undersigned judges;

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4 **ORDERED:** That any party to the Disgorgement Stipulation may seek a modification of
5 the provisions of this order by noticed motion to this Disciplinary Panel within 20 days of the
6 date of entry.
