Based on the Memorandum of Disciplinary Proceeding against Marcella C Oka filed concurrently with this Order pursuant to Third Amended General Order 96-95 of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California, it is hereby ORDERED:

1. Marcella Oka is suspended from practicing before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California for two years, commencing upon the effective date of the actual suspension imposed by the State Bar of California pursuant to a Stipulation re Facts, Conclusions of Law and Disposition and Order Approving Actual Suspension, filed as a public matter on December 2010, and running concurrently therewith.

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- 2. Upon Marcella Oka's reinstatement to the California State Bar, she may apply for reinstatement to practice before the Bankruptcy Court.
- 3. Ms. Oka shall undertake and complete additional continuing legal education of ten (10) hours of duration in the area of legal ethics offered by a provider of continuing legal education recognized by the State Bar of California, and submit written proof of completion thereof before she may apply for reinstatement to practice before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California.
- 4. As a further condition to reinstatement to practice before the United States Bankruptcy Court of the Central District of California, Ms Oka shall submit a declaration of a medical doctor (M.D.) that the diabetes which has disabled her has been under control for a period of six months.
- 5. Copies of the Memorandum of Disciplinary Proceeding and this Disciplinary Order shall be served by the Clerk of this Court on each Bankruptcy Judge sitting in the Central District of California, on the Clerk of the United States District Court for the Central District of California, and on the State Bar of California.
