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The Panel held a hearing at the above-captioned time and place. Giovanni Orantes appeared on behalf of Philip E. Koebel, Esq. ("Koebel"), who was also present and presented oral argument to the Panel. No other parties appeared at the hearing. After the hearing, the Panel took the matter under submission. Based upon

1 findings of fact and conclusions of law set forth in the Court's  
2 Memorandum of Decision filed concurrently herewith, it is

3 ORDERED that:

- 4 1. Koebel shall be suspended from filing any new case or  
5 proceeding in this Court for a period of 180 days from the  
6 date of the entry of this Order (the "Suspension Period")  
7 and shall be placed on probation for a period of 4 1/2  
8 years (the "Probation Period") following the Suspension  
9 Period.
- 10 2. As a condition to filing any new case following the end of  
11 the Suspension Period, Koebel shall file a declaration  
12 confirming that he has paid the sanctions awarded against  
13 him in case number 2:13-ap-02078-VZ and in the Chapter 13  
14 Case. Koebel shall serve the declaration on the Office of  
15 the United States Trustee.
- 16 3. If an order is entered in any case pending in the United  
17 States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of  
18 California during either the Suspension Period or the  
19 Probation period that awards sanctions against Koebel in an  
20 amount of \$1,000 or greater, Koebel shall be suspended from  
21 all practice before this Court, including pending cases,  
22 for the remainder of the Suspension Period and the  
23 Probation Period.
- 24 4. The Office of the United States Trustee will monitor  
25 Koebel's compliance with the disciplinary terms and will  
26 file a declaration with the Court in the event that the  
27 United States Trustee identifies circumstances where Koebel  
28 is not in compliance with the court's discipline order.

1 5. Koebel shall complete 4 hours of legal ethics training and  
2 shall file a declaration with proof of such training once  
3 the training has been completed. The legal training must  
4 be completed within 180 days of entry of the order in this  
5 matter.

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


