Based on the Memorandum of Decision in Disciplinary Proceeding against Juan J. Gonzalez, filed concurrently with this Order pursuant to Fourth Amended General Order 96-05 of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California ("General Order"), it is hereby ORDERED:

1. Juan J. Gonzalez is suspended from practicing before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California indefinitely, including that Mr. Gonzalez is barred from utilizing electronic CM/ECF filing privileges, commencing upon the effective date of this Order.

2. Mr. Gonzalez may apply for reinstatement to practice before the Bankruptcy Court in accordance with the provisions of the General Order, as it may be amended hereafter.

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1 3. Without limitation to other conditions that may be imposed upon Mr. Gonzalez in
2 connection with prospective reinstatement, Mr. Gonzalez shall undertake and complete
3 additional continuing legal education totaling at least fifteen (15) hours of duration in the area of
4 legal ethics offered by a provider of continuing legal education recognized by the State Bar of
5 California, and submit written proof of completion thereof, before he may be reinstated to
6 practice before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California.

7 4. Copies of the Memorandum of Decision in Disciplinary Proceeding and this
8 Disciplinary Order shall be served by the Clerk of this Court on each Bankruptcy Judge sitting in
9 the Central District of California, on the Clerk of the United States District Court for the Central
10 District of California, and on the State Bar of California.
