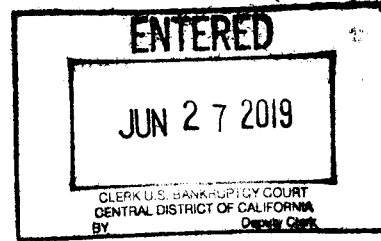
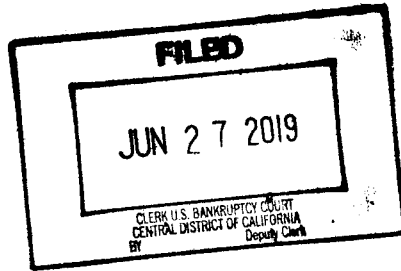

CONDITIONS FOR REINSTATEMENT**


For the reasons set forth in the accompanying Memorandum Decision, it is hereby:  
ORDERED that attorney Michael A. Younge (“Younge”) is suspended from admission to  
appear before any judge of this Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California for a  
period of not less than five (5) years from the date of entry of this order; and it is further  
ORDERED that thereafter Mr. Younge may apply to the Chief Judge of the United States  
Bankruptcy Court, Central District of California, for reinstatement, pursuant to the procedures

1 set forth below and in the Fifth Amended General Order 96-05 of the United States Bankruptcy  
2 Court for the Central District of California (as may be amended from time to time, the “General  
3 Order”); and it is further

4 ORDERED that this order and copies of the Memorandum of Decision issued  
5 concurrently herewith shall be served by the Clerk of this Court on each Bankruptcy Judge  
6 sitting in the Central District of California, on the Clerk of the United States District Court for  
7 the Central District of California, and on the State Bar of California; and it is further

8 ORDERED that to be eligible for reinstatement, Mr. Younge must complete five (5)  
9 hours of continuing legal education on the topic of ethics.
