3 **IT IS ORDERED** as follows:

- 4 1. The Application is hereby granted.
- 5 2. All privileges revoked by the Disciplinary Panel's September 18, 2009 "Order
6 on Disciplinary Proceeding of Benjamin B. Wasson" are hereby reinstated,
7 and the suspension from practice before this Court imposed by that Order is
8 hereby lifted.
- 9 3. Effective upon the entry of this Order, Benjamin Tyler Brandt shall be deemed
10 eligible to practice before all the judges of this court, except to the extent that
11 any judge of this court has issued an order, other than under Fourth Amended
12 General Order 96-05, denying him the right to appear before that judge or to
13 appear in a particular case.
- 14 4. The Clerk shall transmit a copy of this order to the following persons:
- 15 a. all judges of this Court;
- 16 b. Benjamin Tyler Brandt;
- 17 c. the Clerk of the District Court for the Central District of California;
- 18 d. the United States Trustee; and
- 19 e. the State Bar of California.

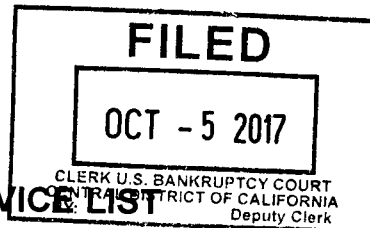
