**GENERAL ORDER 21-03**

Based on the continuation of the Continuity of Operations Plan (“COOP”) implemented on March 18, 2020, and in response to the recent steady decrease in COVID-19 cases in the Central District of California,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that [General Order 21-02](#) closing all Bankruptcy Courts in the District to all in-person operations is **amended** to permit the **Intake** areas of all Divisions of the Bankruptcy Court to open and serve the public in-person **starting on March 22, 2021.**

All other provisions of [General Order 20-12](#) remain in effect. Should the phased re-opening of the Intake areas proceed smoothly and COVID-19 cases in the District continue to decrease, further in-person activities will be authorized in coming weeks.
