**GENERAL ORDER 22-03  
(Supersedes General Order 21-06)**

Upon consideration of the order of United States District Court General Order 22-05,

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** as follows:


The Court’s previously issued [General Order 21-06](#), which included the “Policy Regarding COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing” followed by the amended version of the Policy (viewable at <https://www.cacb.uscourts.gov/sites/cacb/files/documents/Amended%20Vac.Policy.AttestForm.Faq.pdf>) as described in [Public Notice 22-006](#), is rescinded; and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, although the Court rescinds the “Amended Policy Regarding COVID-19 Vaccination and Testing” through this Order, all employees, volunteers, and onsite judiciary contractors are still strongly encouraged to

1 follow the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention’s guidance regarding COVID-19  
2 prevention measures, including staying up to date with their COVID-19 vaccines.
