28	a voluntary bankruptcy case must include the signed "Statement About	

Your Social Security Numbers" (Official Form 121) with the initial filing when mailing the documents (F.R.B.P. 1007(f).). When filing a voluntary bankruptcy case through the court's eSR program, the signed "Statement About Your Social Security Numbers" form must be mailed to the court within ten (10) days of filing, or the case will be dismissed.
