**PROCEDURES REGARDING BOTH TELEPHONIC AND IN-PERSON  
APPEARANCES BEFORE THE HONORABLE BARRY RUSSELL**

The Edward Roybal Federal Building and the United States Courthouse remains open. Enhanced Entry Screening Services are in effect, which include wearing a facemask. All members of the public are required to undergo screening in order to seek entry to the courthouse. The screening process will include a temperature check with a no contact thermometer and five health screening questions. Face masks are required in Judge Russell's courtroom.

**Up through and including September 30, 2020**, appearances on all matters before the Honorable Barry Russell continue to be evaluated on a case-by-case basis to determine whether the hearing will be held telephonically or in person. Court hearings are generally held on Tuesdays. Tentative rulings are posted on the Court's website on Wednesdays prior to Court hearings. It is the movant's responsibility to check the tentative ruling and notify all interested parties of how appearances will be made. CourtCall who is the telephonic provider for the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California continues to offer free access for pro se parties and discounted charges for attorneys through September 30, 2020.

You must arrange for the telephonic appearance yourself by calling CourtCall at (866) 582-6878 by 2:00 p.m. at least two business days prior to the hearing. If you experience any difficulty registering with CourtCall, contact the Courtroom Deputy at (213) 894-3687 or Chambers at (213) 894-6091.
