

JUDGE TIGHE'S REVISED INTERIM PROCEDURES

RE: COVID-19

1. REMOTE HEARINGS

To mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 virus and in light of the recent directives from state and federal officials, all hearings before Judge Tighe will be held remotely until further notice.

The courtroom will be locked; parties must appear by telephone or ZoomGov, as directed by the Court, and will not be permitted to appear in the courtroom. There is no need to contact the Court for permission. Simply contact CourtCall at (888) 882-6878 for hearings that are held telephonically or check the Court's posted calendar for ZoomGov hearing information. It is suggested that parties register with CourtCall as early as possible, at least 30 minutes prior to the hearing.

Through September 30, 2020, CourtCall is offering discounted rates to attorneys and **FREE** access for parties who do not have an attorney (*pro se* parties).

If you have an evidentiary hearing or trial scheduled, the Court will contact you to discuss arrangements.

2. JUDGE'S COPIES NOT REQUIRED THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2020

Judge Tighe will excuse compliance with LBR 5005-2(d) (requiring Judge's copies) through December 31, 2020, at which time the situation will be re-evaluated.

Parties, however, are reminded that the Judge and Chambers' staff do not receive NEF notices of filings; thus, for matters which are not related to matters set for hearing or uploaded LOU orders, Parties must contact Chambers and advise Chambers of the filing at 818-587-2806.
