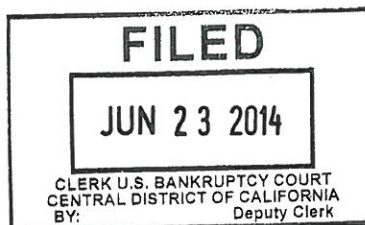

RE: TIME OF CHAPTER 13
CONFIRMATION HEARING




9 The undersigned Judge of the United States Bankruptcy Court, Central
10 District of California, makes this standing order with respect to the time
11 for the hearing on confirmation of Chapter 13 plans:

12 I hereby find and accordingly ORDER that it is in the best interests of
13 the creditors and the estate to hold the hearing on the confirmation of the
14 Chapter plan on the same date as the meeting of creditors required under 11
15 USC § 341(a). Any party in interest who objects to that timing of the
16 confirmation hearing shall file a written objection thereto at least 20
17 calendar days before the scheduled confirmation hearing; and it is

18 FURTHER ORDERED that the objecting party shall file the objection with
19 the Court and serve it on the debtor, debtor's counsel, Chapter 13 trustee,
20 and on any creditor who has filed an objection to confirmation, filed a
21 request for special notice, or holds a security interest in the real property
22 of the debtor. If a timely objection is received, the Court will reschedule
23 the confirmation hearing.
