<b>Only required</b> when opposition to a motion is filed, or when an order requires signatures.	Court Manual section 4.2(b)(4)	
<b>Judge's copy required</b> , <u>but not</u> for orders on relief from stay or to impose/continue the stay.	LBR 5005-2(d), Court Manual section 4.2(b)(6)	
<b>Use the "Notice of Lodgment" event code</b> created specifically for a Notice of Lodgment. <b>Do not use</b> a general notice event code (e.g. Notice).		

## **Bankruptcy Noticing Center (BNC)**

**Bankruptcy Case** - BNC serves <u>all</u> entered orders, but <u>only</u> on the debtor (and debtor's attorney if not served via Notice of Electronic Filing).

Adversary Proceeding - BNC serves <u>all</u> entered orders on <u>all</u> parties (and attorneys if not served via NEF), but <u>only if</u> the adversary docket has a <u>complete</u> address for the party or attorney. [*Court Manual section 4.6*]
