**RE: GENERAL ORDER 22-01 IN RE: PROHIBITION ON
BROADCASTING, TELEVISIONING, RECORDING, AND PHOTOGRAPHING
BANKRUPTCY COURT PROCEEDINGS, INCLUDING HEARINGS
CONDUCTED BY REMOTE TRANSMISSION**

On September 8, 2022, Chief Judge Theodor C. Albert issued [General Order 22-01 In Re: Prohibition on Broadcasting, Televisioning, Recording, and Photographing Bankruptcy Court Proceedings, including Hearings Conducted by Remote Transmission](#). [General Order 22-01](#) was ordered to effectuate the policy of the Judicial Conference which prohibits federal court proceedings from being broadcast, televised, recorded or photographed for the purpose of public dissemination. [General Order 22-01](#) reconciles the use of videoconferencing and telephone conferencing during the COVID-19 pandemic with the Judicial Conference's policy, as remote transmission was not expressly addressed in the applicable Local Bankruptcy Rule (LBR 5073-1).
