PROPOSED OVERBID PROCEDURES

The Trustee proposes the following procedure to allow for overbids prior to the Court's approval of the Sale of the Assets:

1. Qualifying bidders ("Qualifying Bidder") shall:
 - a. Bid at least \$41,000.00 in cash for the Assets (\$30,000.00 for the initial bid + \$5,000.00 initial overbid + \$6,000.00 Breakup Fee);
 - b. Set forth in writing the terms and conditions of the offer that are at least as favorable to the Trustee as those set forth in the Agreement attached as **Exhibit 1**;
 - c. Be financially qualified, in the Trustee's exercise of his sound business judgment, to close the Sale as set forth in the Agreement;
 - d. Submit an offer that does not contain any contingencies to closing the Sale, including, but not limited to, financing contingencies;
 - e. Submit a cash deposit of \$5,000.00 ("Overbid Deposit") payable to Howard R. Ehrenberg, Chapter 7 Trustee for the Bankruptcy Estate of Mark Elias Crone, in the form of a cashier's check, which Overbid Deposit shall be non-refundable if the bid is deemed to be the Successful Bid, as defined in paragraph 4 below.
