 ("Auctioneer") in Perris, California. Inland is advised that its largest secured lienholders,
 Federal Insurance Company ("Federal") and Berkley Regional Insurance Company ("Berkley"),
 have no objection to the proposed auction sale, but this will be confirmed prior to the hearing.

Approving and authorizing Inland to enter into an Auction Contract for the
employment of Auctioneer to coordinate the auction sale and authorizing payment of the
Auctioneer's compensation that includes the principal terms described below. The Auctioneer
and the Debtor are currently preparing the Auction Contract, which will be filed with the Court
prior to the hearing on this Motion.

Inland does not believe that any of the Assets to be sold are subject to lease

2	circumstances of this case.
3	Before payment of the Auctioneer's fees and expenses, the gross proceeds of the auction

4 sale are estimated to be between \$243,000 to \$248,000 based on the values of the Assets set forth
5 below. After payment of the Auctioneer's fees and expenses, the net auction proceeds will be
6 held by Inland in a segregated account subject to the liens and cash collateral agreements with
7 Federal and Berkley or further order of the Court. Concurrent with the filing of this Motion, the
8 Debtors are filing a motion to surcharge the collateral of Federal to cover the costs and expenses
9 incurred by the Debtors to preserve the sold assets.

Finally, approval of the auction sale must be resolved as quickly as possible so that the
Inland may coordinate the auction sale and afford time for the proposed Auctioneer to commence

II. <u>RELEVANT FACTS</u>

14 A. <u>Commencement of the Debtors' Bankruptcy Cases</u>

ASR filed a voluntary petition for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code on
September 20, 2013, Case No. 6:13-bk-25794-MH.

Meridian and Inland each filed their voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the
Bankruptcy Code on October 23, 2013. Meridian is Case No. 6:13-bk-27529-MH; and Inland is
Case No. 6:13-bk-27532-MH.

The Debtors are each continuing in possession of their property, and operating and managing their respective business, as debtors in possession pursuant to Bankruptcy Code Sections 1107 and 1108.

Pursuant to Court order entered on November 1, 2013, the Debtors' Chapter 11 cases are being jointly administered under the case number of ASR.

25 B. <u>Debtors' Background</u>

- 1. <u>ASR Constructors, Inc.</u>
- ASR was incorporated in May 1999 and is a general contractor serving the Inland Empire
 on mainly public works projects. Alan Regotti is ASR's President and Chief Executive Officer.

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Since its incorporation, ASR has completed over 850 public works projects, with clients such as
 cities, school districts, and state and federal governments. Just as a few examples, ASR was the
 general contractor on projects including the Riverside Community College Athletic Complex, the
 Repplier Aquatic Park in Banning, the Larry D. Smith Correctional Facility, and the Multi purpose Buildings at Cabrillo, Citrus, Foothill Knolls, Magnolia, Sycamore and Valencia
 Elementary Schools. At its peak, ASR had over 565 employees and annual revenues of over
 \$150 million.

B Due to the dramatic slowdown in the economy throughout the United States that started
9 in December of 2007 and that continues to this day, ASR suffered significant cash flow problems
10 beginning around 2011. As a result, ASR was unable to meet all of its obligations and was
11 suffering financing problems.

12 All of ASR's projects are bonded by either Berkley or Federal. Pursuant to General 13 Agreements of Indemnity, Berkley and Federal have subrogation and indemnity rights against 14 the assets of the Debtors. Pursuant to the terms of the Indemnity Agreement and performance 15 and payment bonds executed by Federal and Berkley, Federal and Berkley have general rights of 16 subrogation and the Debtors agreed to indemnify Federal and Berkley from any losses they may 17 incur as a result of the bonds issued on behalf of ASR. In addition, in the event of default by 18 ASR, ASR would assign, and Federal or Berkley as the case may be would be authorized to take 19 possession of, all of ASR's projects and contracts to ensure the projects are completed and to 20 take possession of all of ASR's assets as necessary to complete such projects.

21 In March 2013, ASR advised its bonding companies, Federal and Berkley, that it was 22 unable to meet its obligations on bonded projects and its obligations to the sureties under their 23 respective indemnity agreements and surety bonds. Because ASR was unable to complete the 24 work and perform obligations with respect to both payment and performance on the bonded 25 projects, ASR requested the sureties to take such steps necessary or appropriate to perform their 26 obligations as sureties with respect to the bonded projects in order to mitigate losses and 27 expenses. Following this voluntary notice of default, Federal and Berkley took over 28 management of the ASR's projects and ASR executed assignments of its receivables to the

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sureties. Federal and Berkley have also been provided with blanket liens on ASR's accounts
 receivables and construction projects as follows:

Federal in the amount of \$1,770,817.66: UCC-1 Filing UCC-1 Filing No. 127339143518 filed 11/28/12; Amendment No. 13-73536425 filed 3/22/13; Amendment No. 1373522998 filed 3/15/13; Amendment No. 13-73517704 filed 3/11/13 and Amendment No. 1373513989 filed 3/6/13

7 • Berkley in the amount of \$129,000.00: UCC-1 Filing No. 13-7366919227 filed
8 6/26/2013.

9 Federal has taken over ASR's construction projects it has bonded but has requested
10 ASR's assistance with respect to various administrative matters related to same. Further, there
11 are two remaining open projects where Berkley is the surety and ASR is providing construction
12 and administrative services, specifically at Adelanto United School District and the Barstow
13 Community College District - Wellness Center ("Projects") which are each approximately 80%
14 complete. ASR expects that it will complete the Projects by no later than February 2015.

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2. <u>Another Meridian Company, LLC</u>

Meridian is in the business of real estate and owns the following real properties:

Wilson Street Property, consisting of a light industrial building located at: 5230
Wilson Street, Jurupa Valley, California which was sold pursuant to an order entered on January
16, 2014. Upon closing of the sale, the first and second priority liens of Zions Bank and Wells
Fargo Bank were paid in full and the remaining proceeds of approximately \$1,890,000 are being
held by Meridian in a segregated account to which Federal's third priority lien and Berkley's
fourth priority lien attach.

Phelan Property: Single family residence located at 3758 Kreuer Rd, Phelan, CA
92371. The Court approved the sale of the Phelan Property at a hearing held on July 29, 2014.
Upon closing of the sale, the estimated net proceeds of \$51,000 will be held by the Debtor in a
segregated account to which Federal's cross-collateralized lien will attach. The Phelan Property
is encumbered only by Federal's first priority cross-collateralized lien.

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Two parcels of vacant land located in the city of Perris, County of Riverside, CA:
Parcel Nos.: 317-270-001 (10.09 acres) and 317-270-012 (9.66 acres) with a value of
approximately \$470,000. This property is subject to the cross-collateralized lien in favor of
Federal.

Two parcels of vacant land located in the city of San Bernardino, County of San
Bernardino, CA: Parcel Nos.: 0142-042-01 (1.889 acres) and 0269-271-17 (1.3 acres) with a
value of \$240,000. This property is subject to the cross-collateralized lien in favor of Federal.

8 The Federal and Berkley liens (consisting of deeds of trust and UCC-1 filings) impacting 9 Meridian's assets were provided as part of agreements with Federal and Berkley to provide 10 funding for completion of ASR projects, to secure obligations owed to Federal and Berkley 11 under indemnity agreements signed by Meridian and otherwise and to forbear from enforcement 12 of remedies available for default..

13

3. <u>Inland Machinery, Inc.</u>

Inland is in the business of machinery and equipment rental. ASR rents machinery and
equipment from Inland as necessary for its various construction projects.

Prior to the commencement of its bankruptcy case, on October 16, 2013, Inland had Auctioneer conduct an auction sale of Inland's machinery and equipment. The net sale proceeds after payment of costs and the auctioneer's commission were approximately \$326,000. During this case, with Court approval, with the assistance of Auctioneer, Inland conducted another auction sale in March, 2014 which generated net proceeds of approximately \$320,000 which are being held by Inland in a segregated account.

Inland's remaining machinery and equipment is believed to be worth approximately
\$400,000, some of which will be included in the auction sale that is the subject of this Motion.

Inland's net auction proceeds and remaining machinery equipment are subject to the cross-collateralized liens of Federal and Berkley. The Federal and Berkley liens impacting Inland's assets were provided as part of agreements with Federal and Berkley to provide funding for completion of ASR projects, to secure obligations owed to Federal and Berkley under

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indemnity agreements signed by Inland and otherwise and to forbear from enforcement of
 remedies available for default.

3

C. Events Leading to the Chapter 11 Filings

4 As set forth above, with the downturn in the economy, ASR suffered crippling cash flow 5 problems. ASR has also incurred significant legal fees and expenses related to the defense of 6 multiple collection lawsuits that have been filed against ASR, a few of which Meridian and 7 Inland have been named as co-defendants. However, one of the principal factors for the filing of 8 the bankruptcy cases was a \$6,655,486.47 judgment being asserted against ASR's contractors' 9 license by Gottte. Specifically, ASR received a notice from the Board advising that the ASR was 10 required to submit to the Board by September 22, 2013 either (1) proof that the \$6,655,486.47 11 judgment in favor of Gotte had been paid, or (2) proof of ASR's bankruptcy filing. In addition, 12 following entry of the judgment against ASR, Gotte filed a second lawsuit that was commenced in the Riverside Superior Court, styled Gotte Electric, Inc., v. ASR Constructors, Inc., Federal 13 14 Insurance Company, Another Meridian, LLC and Inland Machinery, Inc., Case No. RIC 1310089 ("Gotte State Court Action") seeking recovery of alleged fraudulent transfers.² 15

As ASR did not have the funds to pay the disputed judgment and the second Gotte State Court Action was impacting each of the Debtors, it was determined that the best way to maximize everyone's recovery was for the Debtors to file their respective bankruptcy cases so that (1) ASR could move forward with the completion of pending jobs, (2) Meridian and Inland could move forward to conduct orderly sales of their respective assets, and (3) each of the companies could wind down their affairs in an orderly fashion..

D. <u>The Marketing of Inland's Assets</u>

Inland has been investigating alternatives for maximizing the value of its assets for thebenefit of all of its creditors and other parties in interest.

Inland has contacted or has been contacted by parties who have expressed an interest in
the purchase of Inland's assets. Several interested parties have met with Inland's management

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² ASR has removed the Gotte State Court Action to the Bankruptcy Court. The Debtors intend to explore settlement of the Gotte State Court Action.

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1 and/or performed due diligence. Inland received approximately six (6) offers from such parties. 2 Inland received offers from these parties to either buy the assets outright or to conduct an auction 3 but most offered only bids that were too low or subject to significant contingencies. The outright 4 offers were much lower than the projected auction sale proceeds. When Inland considered all 5 offers from parties to conduct an auction, Inland chose the Auctioneer because Inland is 6 comfortable with the Auctioneer in that the Auctioneer has conducted successful auctions for 7 Inland in the past and Auctioneer's proposal for compensation is competitive. As such, in light 8 of the current economic environment, Inland's financial condition and the fact that Inland is no 9 longer using the Assets to be sold, Inland believes the only option available is the orderly auction 10 sale of the Assets of related to its equipment and machinery rental business.

As such, it appears that an auction sale of the Assets is the best way to maximize value
for creditors and will be more beneficial to the Estate as compared to attempting to sell each item
on a piecemeal basis.

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E. <u>The Proposed Auction Sale of Inland's Assets</u>

The Assets which are the subject of the Auction Motion are generally described as
equipment and machinery used in Inland's rental business and. A complete list of the items to be
included in the auction is as follows:

The Assets to be sold do not include all of Inland's machinery and equipment as some of 20 it is still being utilized by ASR in the completion of pending projects. Once pending ASR 21 projects are completed (estimated time of six months), subject to further motion and Court order 22 at a later date, Inland intends to sell its remaining machinery and equipment not included in the 23 current auction sale. 24

Inland does not believe that any of the Assets to be sold are subject to lease interests. 25 However, out of an abundance of caution, in the event that it is determined that any of the Assets 26 are subject to a lease interest, such leased items will only be sold if there is equity for the Estate 27 and the lessor consents to the sale. 28

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1 Inland believes that the auction sale may generate gross proceeds of approximately 2 \$243,000 to \$248,000 based on the current business environment and the estimated values set 3 forth above. Through the competitive bidding of a public auction sale, it is anticipated that 4 Inland will receive the best and highest value for the Assets and therefore, the ultimate sale price 5 of the Assets will be fair and reasonable.

9 G. <u>Tax Consequences</u>

At this time, Inland does not know what the capital gains taxes liability will be, if any,
generated by the sale. In the event that there is any tax liability generated from the sale, it is
anticipated that such taxes will be paid by the sale proceeds.

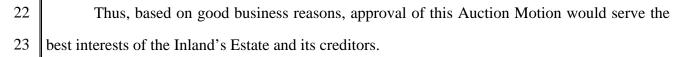
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K. <u>Approval of the Auction Motion Serves the Best Interests of the Estate and</u> <u>Creditors</u>
