1 *Bidder as Good-Faith Purchaser Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 363(m); and (4) Approving*  
2 *Compromise of Controversy Pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9019*  
3 *("Motion") filed by Weneta M.A. Kosmala, the chapter 7 trustee ("Trustee") of the*  
4 *bankruptcy estate ("Estate") of Blue Cargo Group, LLC ("Debtor").*

5 By the Motion, the Trustee seeks an order of the Court authorizing the Trustee to  
6 sell the Corporate Claims (defined herein) of the Estate for a purchase price of  
7 \$50,000.00, subject to overbid.

### 8 Background

9 On August 5, 2021 ("Petition Date"), an involuntary Chapter 11 petition was filed  
10 against Blue Cargo Group, LLC, by petitioning creditors Blu Logistics (China) Co., Ltd.,  
11 Istmus Investments, LLC, and Blue Cargo Hong Kong Limited, case no. 8:21-bk-11917-  
12 ES ("Case"). The order for relief was entered on September 7, 2021. Debtor converted  
13 its case from Chapter 11 to Chapter 7 on September 9, 2021. Shortly thereafter, Weneta  
14 M.A. Kosmala was appointed Chapter 7 Trustee.

15 On September 22, 2021, Debtor filed its schedules in which it listed \$92,434.43 in  
16 personal property assets, including \$62,918.29 in bank accounts, \$28,136.14 in accounts  
17 receivable, and \$1,380.00 in domain names. Debtor scheduled \$3,936,281.18 in secured  
18 claims, \$1,186.39 in priority unsecured claims, and \$3,780,125.27 in nonpriority  
19 unsecured claims.

20 Prior to the Petition Date, one of the Debtor's insiders, Seldat Distribution, Inc.  
21 ("Seldat") commenced litigation in the Circuit Court of the 11<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, in and for  
22 Miami-Dade County, Case No. 127399617 against the Debtor and the Debtor's other  
23 insiders and/or related parties: Paul Conolly; David Kassin; Transglobal Florida, LLC; Paul  
24 D. Conolly and Cara M. Conolly, Co-Trustees of the Conolly Family Trust, dated July 12,  
25 2005; James Conolly and Anna Conolly, Co-Trustees of The Conolly Family Trust, dated  
26 October 4, 2017; and Blue Cargo Group, LLC dba Blue Logistics ("Florida State Court  
27 Action").

28 The claims asserted in the Florida State Court Action included, but were not limited  
to, Breach of the Operating Agreement and Breach of Fiduciary Duties against some or all  
of the Released Parties (identified herein). The claims for collection of Seldat's  
promissory note against the Debtor are not intended to be affected, released or in any  
way impacted by the Agreement (defined herein).

In addition to the Florida State Court Action, Seldat's principal, Daniel Dadoun has  
threatened at various times some or all of the Released Parties of breach of fiduciary duty,  
alter ego, self-dealing and other corporate governance claims. These claims, along with  
the claims specified in the Florida State Court Action or not presently asserted but held by  
the Trustee on behalf of the Corporate Debtor, Blue Cargo, Inc., are referred to as the  
"Corporate Claims."

The Trustee seeks to settle and resolve all disputes and claims with the following  
named persons, entities and/or corporations and any Insiders (as defined under Section  
101(31) of the Bankruptcy Code) and/or Affiliates (as defined under Section 101(2) of the  
Bankruptcy Code): Paul D. Conolly; David Kassin; Transglobal Florida, LLC; Paul D.  
Conolly and Cara M. Conolly, Co-Trustees of the Conolly Family Trust, dated July 12,  
2005; James Conolly; James Conolly and Anna Conolly, Co-Trustees of the Conolly  
Family Trust, dated October 4, 2017; Blu Logistics Colombia, SAS; Christoph Sielfeld  
Lyon; OSE Trucking, LLC; Oceanstar, Inc.; Blu Logistics China; Blue Cargo Hong Kong;  
and KC Global Logistics, Inc. (together, "Released Parties"), and the Released Parties

1 seek to purchase the Corporate Claims whether specified in the Florida State Court Action  
2 or not presently asserted, but yet held by the Chapter 7 Trustee on behalf of the  
3 Corporate Debtor, Blue Cargo, Inc., and to settle and resolve all disputes and claims  
4 between them. The Agreement will not in any way settle and/or release in any way or  
5 impact any claims under Sections 544, 547, 548, and/or 549 of the Bankruptcy Code  
6 against any of the Released Parties.

7 Besides the Released Parties' offer, the Trustee has received no other offer to  
8 purchase the Corporate Claims. Therefore, the proposed sale and settlement with the  
9 Released Parties constitutes the best means of obtaining a benefit from the Corporate  
10 Claims for the Estate's creditors. In the event any other party values the Corporate  
11 Claims more, the Trustee seeks to set a sale hearing with overbid procedures to allow for  
12 the potential overbid of the Corporate Claims.

13 With respect to Seldat, in its bankruptcy schedules, the Debtor listed (i) claims  
14 against Seldat to defend *alto ego* claims, in an unspecified amount, and (ii) \$1.2 million in  
15 trade debt (loan) owing to Seldat which is scheduled as being subject to a lien. Dkt. 23,  
16 pages 13 and 18. The Schedules do not include the Corporate Claims. Dkt. 23.

17 No liens exist that in any way affect the ability of the Trustee to transfer the rights to  
18 proceed with the Corporate Claims. Furthermore, no secured claims were filed that relate  
19 to or encumber the Corporate Claims in any manner.

### 20 Summary of Proposed Sale and Settlement

21 The Trustee and the Released Parties (together, "Parties") seek to settle and  
22 resolve all disputes and claims between them. Therefore, the Parties have entered into  
23 the *Settlement Agreement re: Insiders/Related Parties' Acquisition of Debtor's Litigation*  
24 *Claims* ("Agreement"), a copy of which is attached to the Motion. The salient terms of the  
25 Agreement and the proposed sale ("Sale") and settlement ("Settlement") are as follows:

- 26 1. Effective Date. The Agreement shall become effective upon (a) the  
27 Trustee's receipt of the Payment (defined below), including the amount of  
28 any overbid in the event the Released Parties are the successful bidders in  
an overbid situation, and (b) entry of a Final Order of the Bankruptcy Court  
in the Debtor's Bankruptcy Case approving the same ("Effective Date"). An  
order becomes a Final Order in the Bankruptcy Case fifteen days after its  
entry unless an appeal is timely-filed and a stay pending appeal is obtained,  
in which case the order will become final after the stay pending appeal is  
lifted or removed.
2. Bankruptcy Court Approval. Promptly after the execution of the Agreement  
and the payment of the Deposit (defined below), the Trustee shall promptly  
file a motion seeking Bankruptcy Court approval of the Agreement  
("Motion"). The Motion shall be filed pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy  
Procedure 9019 and any other applicable Federal and/or Local Bankruptcy  
Rules, including the right of interested Parties to overbid the Released  
Parties' Initial Bid as provided herein. No Effective Date will occur if the  
Bankruptcy Court denies approval of the Motion.
3. Initial Bid. The Released Parties shall make an initial bid of \$50,000 (Fifty  
Thousand Dollars) ("Payment") for the Corporate Claims described herein.  
Further, the Released Parties shall be defined as the Stalking Horse Bidder,  
for \$50,000, only to be increased by any overbids with the first highest  
overbid to be \$55,000 (Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars), and to increase in  
minimal increments of no less than \$1,000 (One Thousand Dollars).

- 1 4. Deposit. The Released Parties shall deposit \$25,000 (Twenty-Five
- 2 Thousand Dollars) ("Deposit") upon being presented with a complete
- 3 executed copy of this Agreement. In the event the Released Parties are the
- 4 successful bidders under this Agreement, the complete remaining Payment
- 5 and to the extent increased by any overbids, shall be due and payable to the
- 6 Chapter 7 Trustee on or before the fifteenth (15<sup>th</sup>) calendar day after the
- 7 Bankruptcy Court enters the Order approving this Agreement.
- 8 5. Release of Claims. Upon the Effective Date, the Parties shall provide the
- 9 release of claims set forth in the Agreement.

**Summary of Basis for Relief**

The Agreement will result in the receipt of funds into the Debtor's Estate for purpose of distribution to the Debtor's creditors. Furthermore, while the Corporate Claims may have an uncertain value, by adhering to sale procedures, the Trustee hopes to obtain the highest value for the Corporate Claims by allowing any and all parties to bid on the Corporate Claims pursuant to the terms of the Agreement and the Motion. Accordingly, the Trustee requests that the Bankruptcy Court enter an order granting the Motion.

**Summary of Relief Sought by the Motion**

By the Motion, the Trustee seeks entry of an order providing for the following relief:

- 1 1. Finding that notice of the Motion is proper and adequate;
- 2 2. Approving the Agreement which is attached to the Motion, authorizing the
- 3 Trustee to settle the Corporate Claims with the Released Parties pursuant to 11 U.S.C.
- 4 § 363(b), determining that the Released Parties are entitled to the protections of § 363(m),
- 5 and authorizing the Trustee to enter into the Agreement;
- 6 3. Authorizing the Trustee to execute any documents or take any actions
- 7 reasonably necessary to effectuate the terms of the Agreement;
- 8 4. Waiving any requirements for lodging periods imposed by Local Bankruptcy
- 9 Rule 9021-1 and any other applicable bankruptcy rules;
- 10 5. Waiving the stay imposed by Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 6004(h)
- 11 and any other applicable bankruptcy rules; and
- 12 6. For such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.

The Motion is on file with the Bankruptcy Court.
