**ORDER DENYING REQUEST OF  
DEBTOR'S HUSBAND ON HER BEHALF  
FOR RECONSIDERATION ON MOTION FOR  
RELIEF FROM THE AUTOMATIC STAY  
DECIDED ON 08/27/19**

Having considered the Request of Bob Elias, Debtor Angie Elias's husband, on her behalf for Reconsideration on Motion for Relief from the Automatic Stay Decided on 08/27/19 ("Motion") (Docket No. 28) filed on August 27, 2019, the court denies the Motion because: (1) Mr. Elias lacks standing to act for Debtor since he has not shown that he is an attorney at law licensed to practice before this court, and Debtor as a self-represented party generally has to appear for herself in this case as required by Local Bankruptcy Rule 9011-2; and (2) there is nothing to reconsider because the court did not rule upon the Motion for Relief for the Automatic Stay because the dismissal of the case on August 13, 2019 rendered the motion for stay relief moot pursuant to 11 U.S.C.
